RE:

All campers involved in the aftercare program must be picked-up by **5:30pm sharp**. Any camper not picked-up by the scheduled time of 5:30pm shall be charged \$1.00 per minute per child in late pick-up time fees effective immediately. This late charge penalty is not an extension of the after camp program; each camper will be given three (3) late pick-ups. After the third late pick-up your camper will not be eligible for the after camp program and will need to be picked-up at the end of camp each day at 3pm, and you will forfeit any monies paid toward the aftercare program.

Please be considerate of our staff and make all pick-ups before 5:30pm. We understand that emergencies come up, but also realize that we are scheduled to be out of the school by 5:30pm daily and our schedule is set as such. So please be prepared that if an emergency comes up and you can not pick-up your child/children have a neighbor or other family member on stand by to pick-up your child/children by 5:30pm.

If campers are not picked up by 6pm the Denville Police will be called and your child will be transported by the Denville Police Department to the Denville Police Station located in the Denville Municipal Building (1 St. Mary's Place). A staff member will follow and will stay with your child in the lobby with your child until your child is picked up. If this happens your camper will not be eligible for the after camp program and will need to be picked-up at the end of camp each day at 3pm, and you will forfeit any monies paid toward the aftercare program.
